Simple Present Tense Verbs for He/She/It and Singular Nouns

Spelling Rules	Examples	
With most verbs, add s	live - live <mark>s</mark> sit — sit <mark>s</mark> stay - stay <mark>s</mark>	
Ending in consonant + y change y to i and add es	t ry – tr <mark>ies</mark> car ry – carries	
Ending in s, z, ch, or x add es	miss – misses buzz – buzzes catch – catches fix - fixes	
Exceptions	go – goes do - does	

Simple Present Tense

- Mary feeds her dog. (feed)
- Peter enjoys the food. (enjoy)
- > Tim always cooks the dinner. (cook)
- Tim watches TV every night. (watch)
- May usually dresses in pink. (dress)
- > Bob never washes his car. (wash)
- y → ies > The baby cries loudly. (cry)
 - Peter carries a heavy bag. (carry)
 - Tina dries the dishes every night. (dry)


