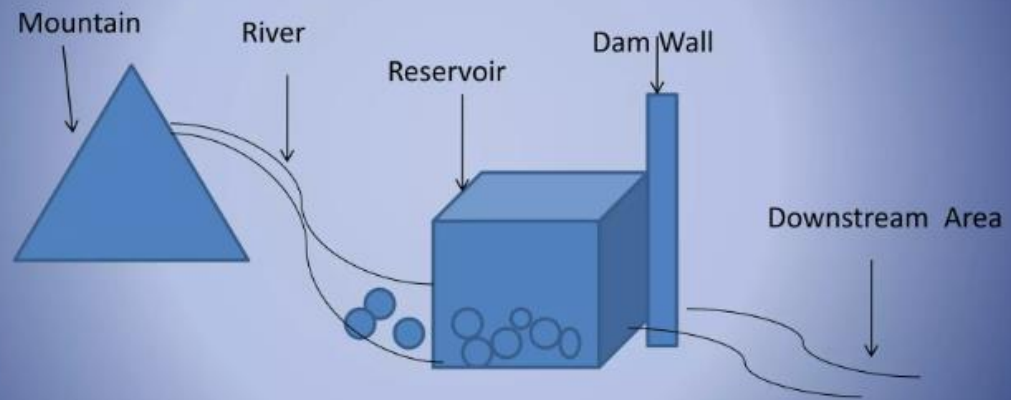


- Continuation of traditional way in Modern India by building dams in the most of the river basin.



Drawbacks of Dams

1. Affect the natural flow of rivers





- In arid and semi-arid regions, agriculture fields were converted into rain fed storage structures that allowed the water to stagnant and moisten the soil like “Khadins” in Jaisalmer and the “johads” in other parts of Rajasthan.
