4. Which expression equals $8 \times 6 - (24 \div 3)$?
(a) $48 - 8$ (b) $8 \times (6 - 3)$ (c) $(8 \times 6) \div 3$ (d) $8 \times 6 - 3 \times 8$

In the following questions 9 and 10, a statement of assertion (A) is followed by a statement of reason (R). Mark the correct choice as: (a) Both assertion (A) and reason (R) are true and reason (R) is the correct explanation of assertion (A). (b) Both assertion (A) and reason (R) are true but reason (R) is not the correct explanation of assertion (A). (c) Assertion (A) is true but reason (R) is false. (d) Assertion (A) is false but reason (R) is true.

5. **Assertion (A):** In $14 + 20 \div 5$, division is done before addition.

Reason (R): Division and multiplication have higher precedence than addition and subtraction.

8. A local bakery produces 120 pastries a day. These are packed equally in 6 boxes. However, due to high demand, the manager decided to add 2 extra pastries in each box. How many pastries are in each box now? 3
