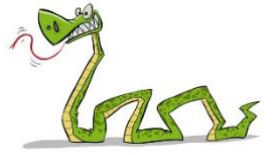


SNAKE CHARMER WORKSHEET

The poor snake soon revived, and when it had enough strength, he bit the farmer who had been so kind to him. The bite was deadly, and the farmer realized that he would die. As

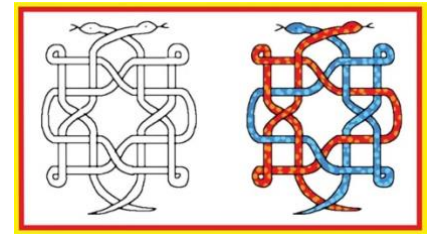


the farmer drew his last breath, he said to the people standing around that they should learn from his mistake – A snake will always bite you even if you save his life.
