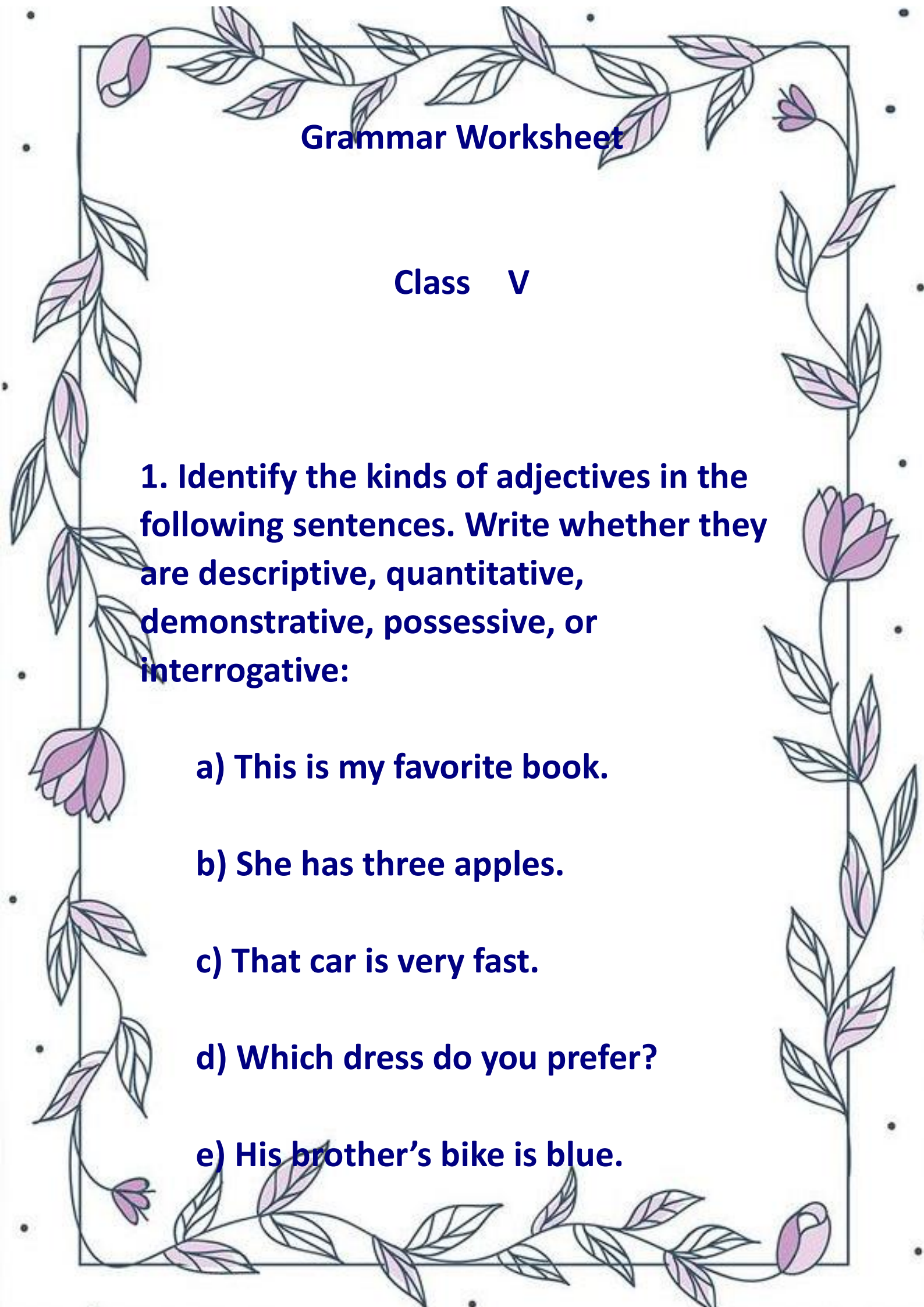

1. Identify the kinds of adjectives in the following sentences. Write whether they are descriptive, quantitative, demonstrative, possessive, or interrogative:

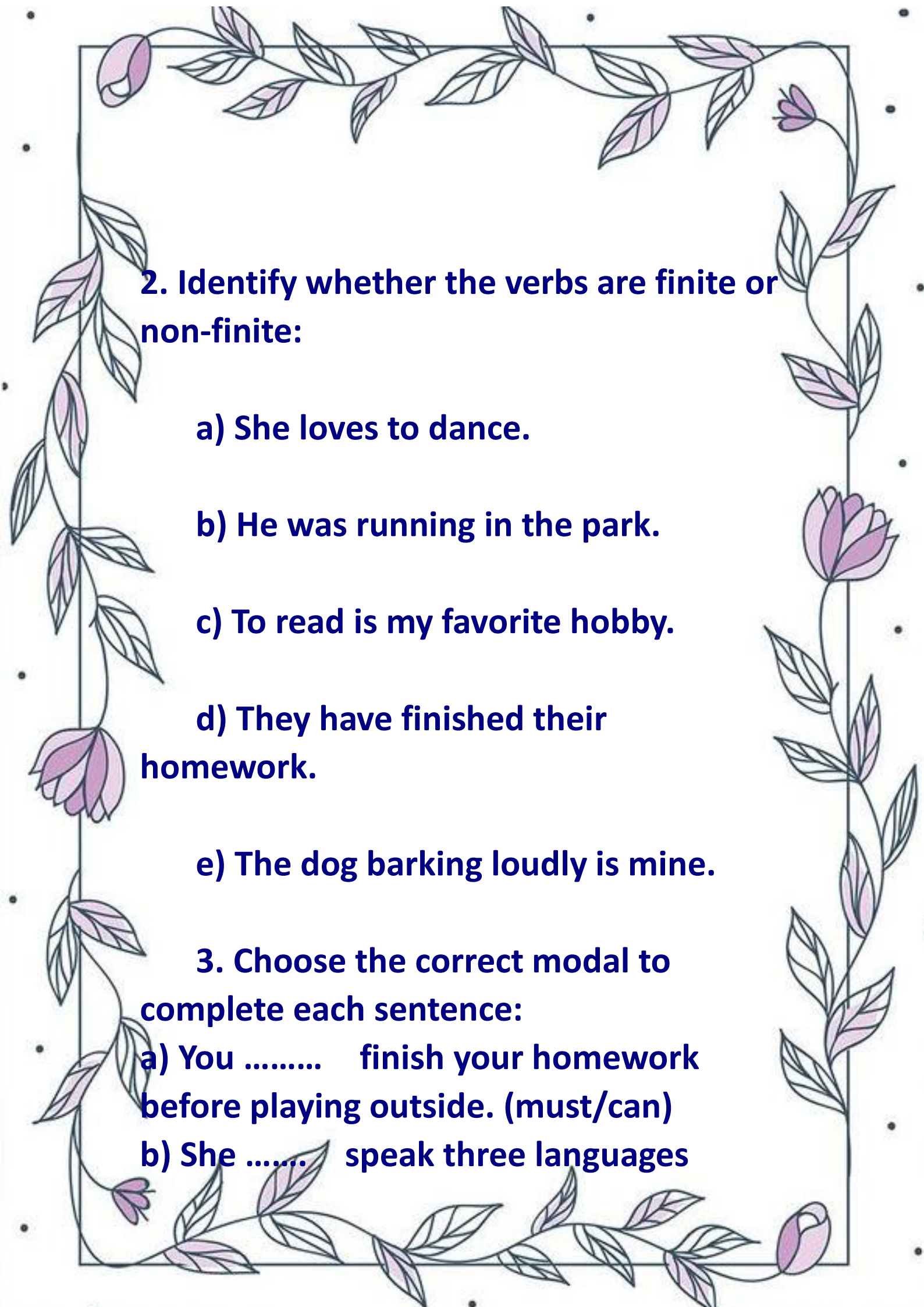
a) This is my favorite book.

c) To read is my favorite hobby.

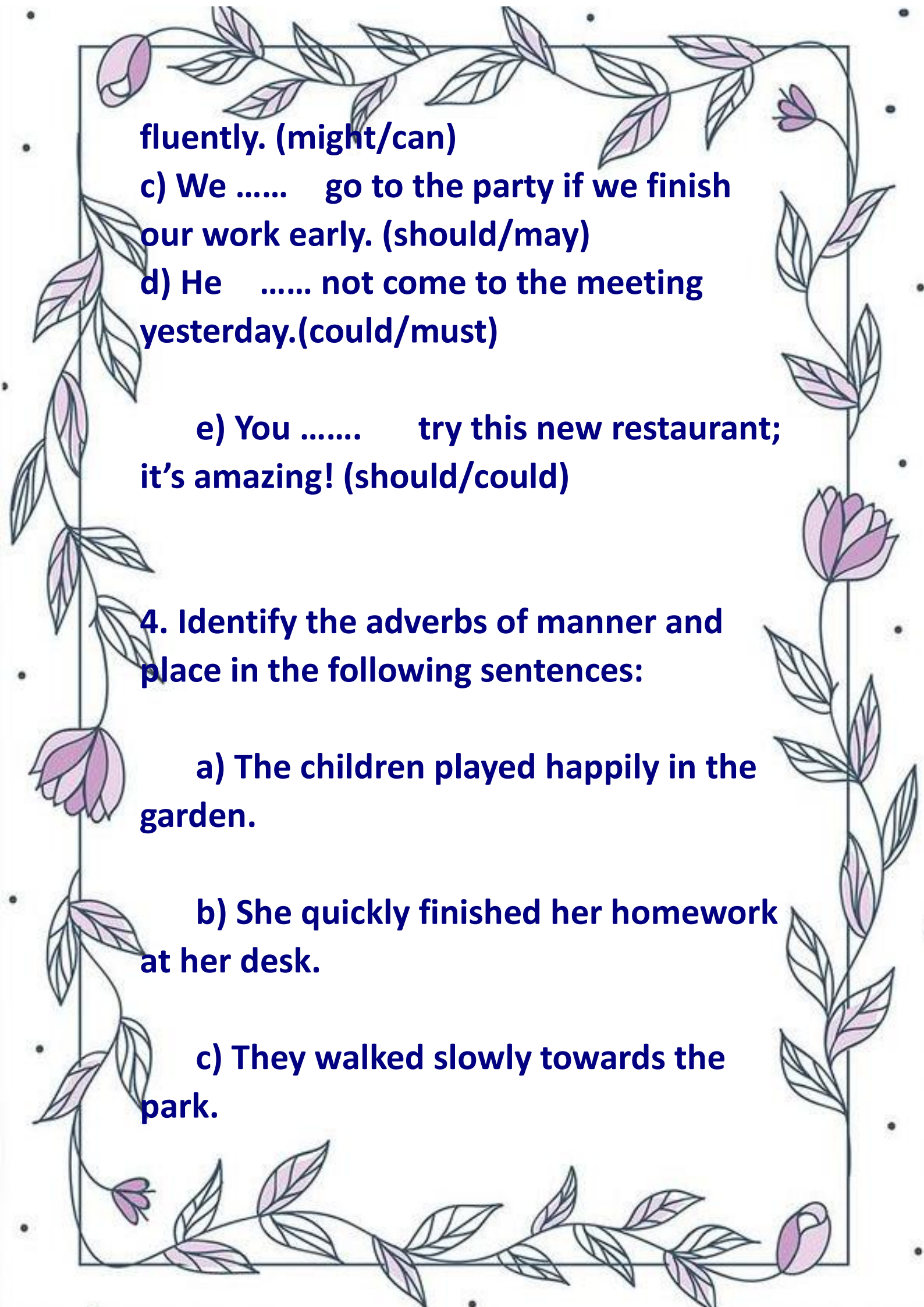
d) They have finished their homework.

d) He not come to the meeting yesterday.(could/must)

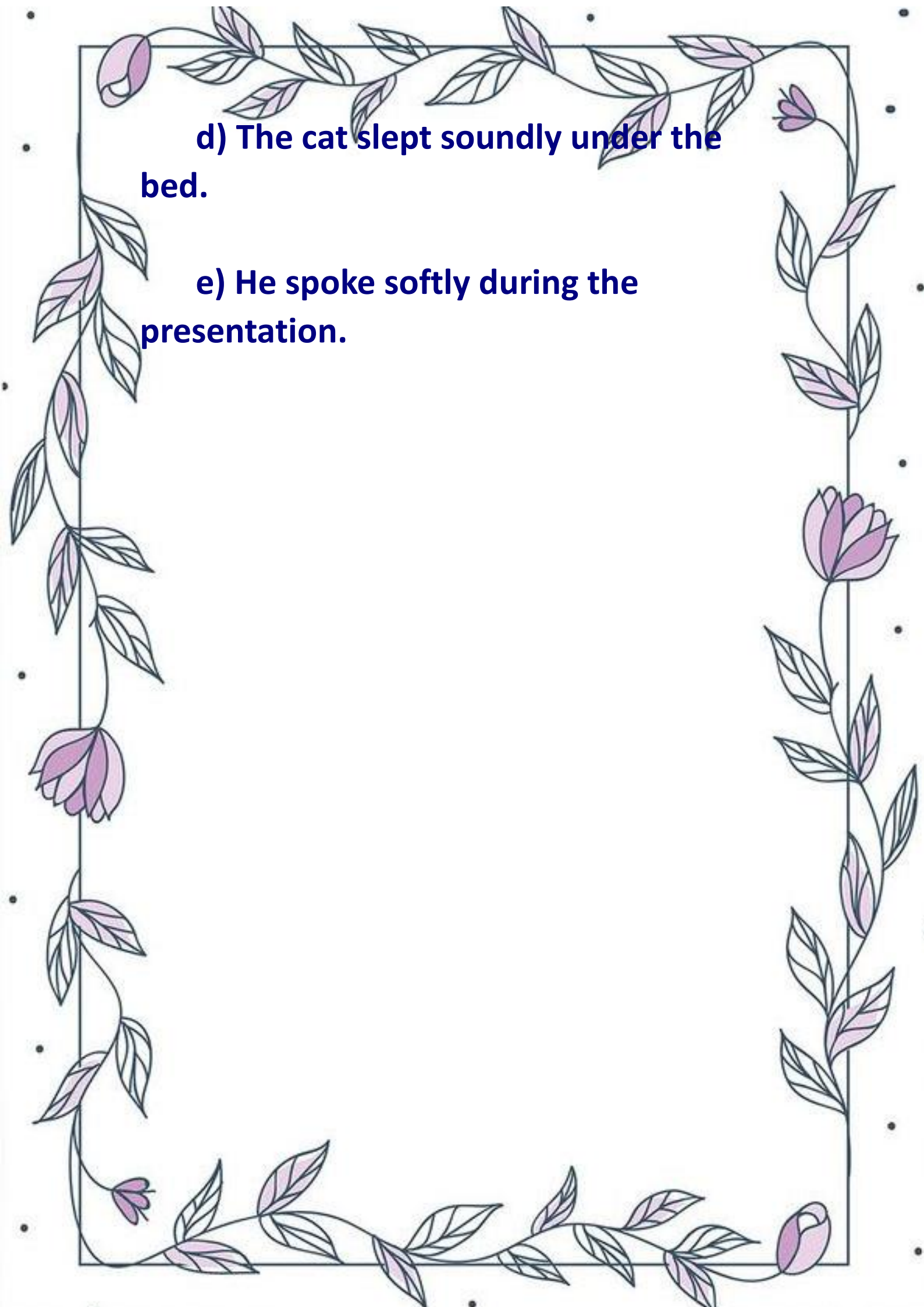
e) You try this new restaurant; it's amazing! (should/could)
