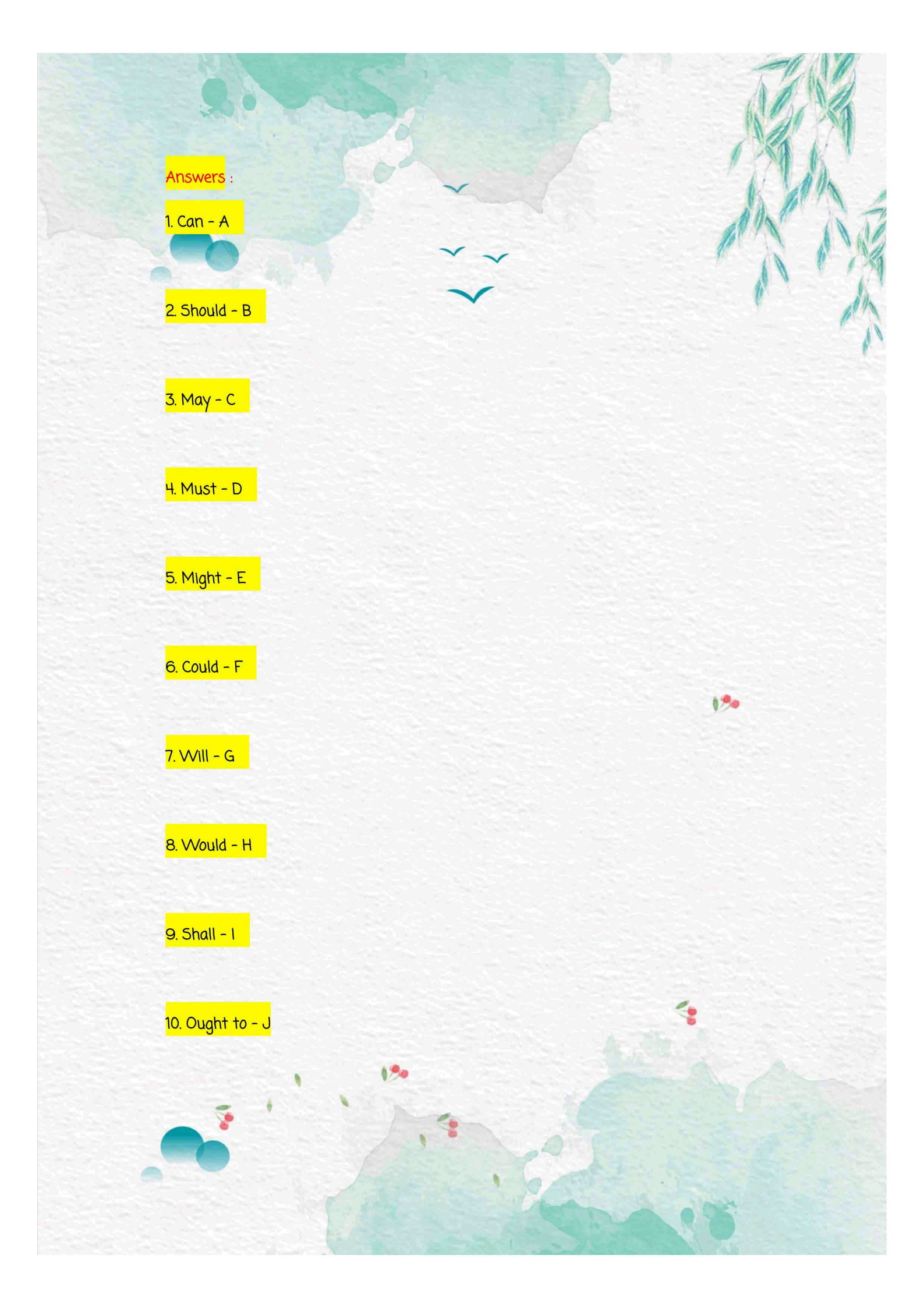


### Match the Columns on Modal Auxiliaries

Column A (Modal Auxiliaries) | Column B (Usage/Meanings )

| Col A    | Col B                                     |
|----------|-------------------------------------------|
| Can      | Ability or permission                     |
| Should   | Obligation or duty                        |
| May      | Possibility or permission                 |
| Must     | Strong necessity or compulsion            |
| Might    | Less probability                          |
| Could    | Past ability or polite request            |
| Will     | Future intention or certainty             |
| Would    | Polite request or hypothetical situations |
| Shall    | Suggestion or formal promise              |
| Ought to | Moral obligation                          |
