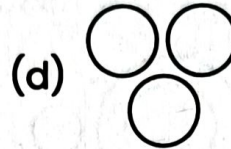
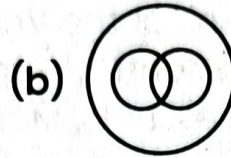
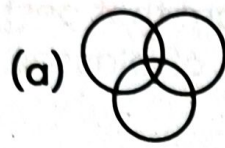

Pumpkin, Spinach, Potato

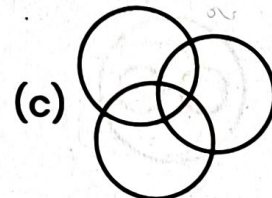
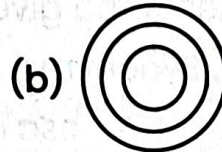
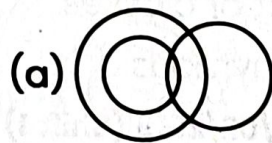

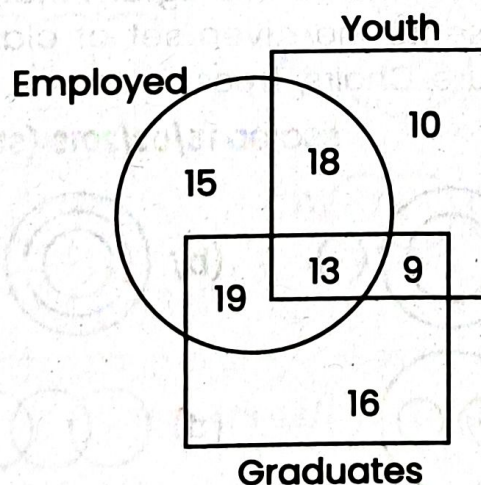
