Used with uncountable nouns (information).

2. This

Refers to a singular object close to the speaker.

3. Those

Refers to plural objects far from the speaker.

4. a few

Shows a small but positive number of friends (plural countable).

5. The few

Refers to the limited number of students who came early—specific group.

6. little

Means almost no sugar (negative sense with uncountable nouns).

7. few

Shows very small number, negative meaning (countable noun: errors).

8. Those

Files (plural) at a distance.

9. any

Used in negative/unknown sense — no idea.

10. their

Possessive pronoun referring to “they.”

11. Many

Used with plural countable noun (questions).

12. a little

Small but sufficient amount of data (uncountable noun).
