QA. Answer the following questions in 40-50 words

1. William Blake criticizes an education system that ignores children's happiness. Evaluate how the poem shows that learning should be joyful. How does joyful learning help in the emotional and moral development of a child?
2. The experience at the summit leads the author to humility rather than pride. Explain briefly why this feeling is important to understand the idea of the "summit within."
3. The narrator wants to buy jalebis but also feels responsible for his money. Explain in short how this struggle between desire and responsibility teaches him an important lesson about self-control and maturity.
4. Keats describes different seasons and contrasts in nature. Explain in short how he uses these contrasts to show harmony and balance in the natural world instead of conflict.
5. The author describes both the physical climb of Mount Everest and the idea of the "summit within." Compare how the outer climb and the inner climb are different in terms of effort, learning, and personal growth.
