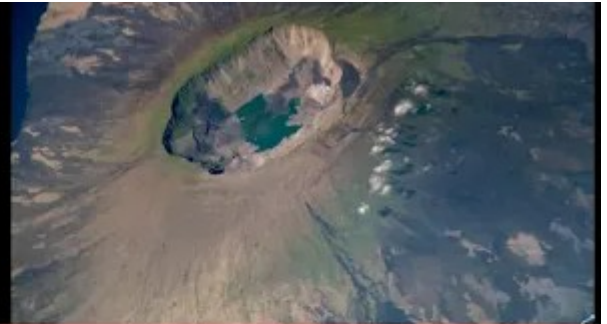


COMPOSITE OR STRATO VOLCANOES

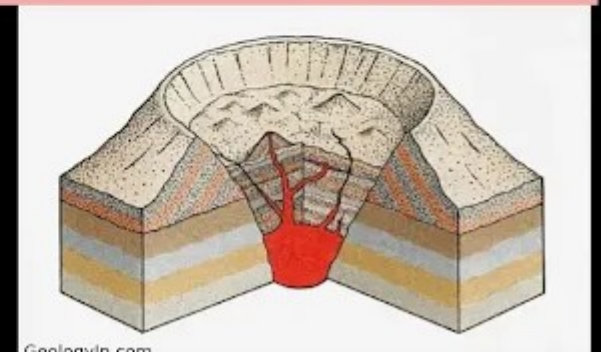
Composite volcanoes are made up of alternating layers of lava and ash (other volcanoes just consist of lava).
