What are Islands?

An island is a piece of land surrounded by water on all sides.

Features

- Surrounded by water.
- Smaller than a continent.
- Can have forests, beaches, and mountains.

Largest Island

Greenland is the largest island in the world.

Examples

Greenland, Sri Lanka, Madagascar, Iceland.

Archipelago

What is an Archipelago?

An archipelago is a group of islands located close to each other.

Features

- Made up of many islands.
- Surrounded by water.
- Found in seas and oceans.

Examples

Indonesia, Japan, Andaman and Nicobar Islands, Lakshadweep.

Remember

Island = One island

Archipelago = Group of islands
