ANTONYMS

- happy / unhappy – feeling joy / feeling sad or displeased
- worried / relieved – feeling anxious about something / feeling calm after the anxiety is gone
- asleep / awake – in a state of sleep / not sleeping
- started / finished – began something / completed or ended it
- appeared / disappeared – came into sight / went out of sight
- lonely / together – feeling alone / being in company with others
- sad / cheerful – feeling sorrow / feeling bright and happy

SYNONYMS

- friend / companion / pal – someone you share a bond with
- lonely / alone / isolated – having no one around
- happy / delighted / joyful – feeling great pleasure
- sad / sorrowful / glum – feeling low or unhappy
- play / frolic / romp – to move about happily and energetically
- help / assist / support – to give aid to someone
- cry / weep / sob – to shed tears

PLAYFUL & DESCRIPTIVE PHRASES and their meanings

- "gave him a joyous swing" – playfully moved or rocked him back and forth in a happy, fun way (referring to the elephant using its trunk)
- "playfully splashed water" – gently and mischievously threw water at someone in a fun manner
- "trunk wrapped around" – the elephant's long nose curled gently around the dog, showing a caring, hug-like gesture

- "wagging his tail in delight" – the dog moved his tail rapidly from side to side because he was very happy and excited
- "nuzzled close" – pressed his nose or head gently against the other animal to show affection and comfort
- "brightened up" – suddenly looked happier; the sadness left their face
- "felt a warm glow" – felt a deep, pleasant feeling of happiness and love inside
